1) Grammar (A1) — Temario completo

Fundamentos

- Alphabet & spelling rules (deletreo)
- Basic sentence structure: Subject + Verb + Object
- Word order en afirmación / negación / pregunta

To Be (clave)

- am/is/are: affirmative, negative, questions
- Short answers: Yes, I am / No, I'm not
- Contractions: I'm, you're, he's...

Nouns & Articles

- a/an/the (uso básico)
- Plurals: -s / -es / irregular plurals comunes

• Countable nouns (introducción)

Pronouns & Possessives

- Subject pronouns: I/you/he/she/it/we/they
- Possessive adjectives: my/your/his/her/its/our/their
- Demonstratives: this/that/these/those

Present Simple (básico, obligatorio)

- Affirmative (I work / She works)
- Negative: don't / doesn't
- Questions: Do/Does
- Short answers
- Common verbs: go, like, want, need, have

Have/Has (A1)

- have/has (possession)
- Questions: Do you have...? / Does she have...?

There is / There are

- Affirmative/negative/questions
- Some/any (introducción muy básica)

Prepositions (básicas)

- Place: in/on/under/next to
- Time: in/on/at (intro básica)

Imperatives

- Commands: Open, close, listen
- Negative imperative: *Don't...*

Can/Can't

- Ability: I can swim
- Permission: Can I...?

Adjectives

• Position before noun: a red car

• Basic opposites: big/small, hot/cold

Question words (A1)

- what, where, who, when, why (intro), how
- how old / how much / how many

Past of To Be (introducción A1/A1+)

- was/were: affirmative/negative/questions
- Short answers

- Personal info (name, age, country, phone, email)

- Time (telling time)

Present Continuous

- am/is/are + verb-ing
- Present continuous vs present simple
- Spelling rules for -ing

Past Simple (obligatorio)

- Regular verbs (-ed) pronunciation (/t/ /d/ /ɪd/)
- Irregular verbs (set esencial)
- Questions/negatives con did
- Time expressions: yesterday, last week, ago

Past of To Be (WAS/WERE completo)

- was/were: questions & negatives
- there was/there were (muy común)

Future (A2)

- going to (plans)
- will (predictions / offers)
- Present continuous for arrangements (intro)

Modals

- can/could (ability/polite requests)
- must / have to (obligation)
- should (advice)

Comparatives & Superlatives

- -er/-est, more/most
- Irregular: better/best, worse/worst

Quantifiers

- a/an/some/any
- much/many/a lot of
- few/little (intro)
- enough (intro)

Articles & determiners

- the vs no article (intro funcional)
- this/that/these/those (repaso)

Prepositions (más amplio)

- Place: behind, between, in front of, across from
- Time: before/after/during

Verb patterns básicos

- like/love/hate + -ing
- want/need + to

3) Functions (A2)

- Describe past experiences (past simple)
- Make plans and invitations
- Give directions in detail
- Talk about problems + solutions simples

- Make requests politely (Could you...?)
- Compare options (cheaper, bigger)

- Sentence stress
- Connected speech (gonna/wanna exposure, sin formalizar)
